It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider and accept the Addendum 1 for RFP No. 2023-133, Annual Contract for RFID Tracking Solution for Morgue Services, for the Medical Examiner’s Office, to Superior Information Technologies, LLC d/b/a ANANTICS.

BACKGROUND

On March 5, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142763, awarded RFP No. 2023-133, Annual Contract for RFID Tracking Solution for Morgue Services, for the Medical Examiner’s Office, to Superior Information Technologies, LLC d/b/a ANANTICS.

The award was based upon evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained options to renew for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods.

The contract addendum modifies Section 5.1 of the original agreement to include specific maintenance and support required of Superior Information Technologies, LLC d/b/a ANANTICS, ensuring the hosted server remains at Criminal Justice Information Services compliance standards for the duration of the award.

Addendum 1 to Service Level Agreement for RFP 2023-133

RFID Tracking Solution for Morgue Services

1. BACKGROUND

1.1. This Addendum is made and entered between Superior Information Technologies, LLC. dba Anantics ("ANANTICS") and Tarrant County ("COUNTY"), collectively known as "PARTIES," pursuant to the terms and conditions of RFP 2023-133 Service Level Agreement, dated, March 5, 2024, ("AGREEMENT"). The terms and conditions contained in the AGREEMENT shall govern the relationship of the PARTIES as described herein.

2. SCOPE

2.1. The AGREEMENT is modified as to Section 5.1 SERVICE SCOPE, related to services provided by ANANTICS. Section 5.1 is updated to include the following language:

"Provide management, maintenance, and patching of the Ubuntu Linux Server provided by Tarrant County. Install up-to-date Operating System (OS) patches to maintain industry-level security standards. The OS must be current General Availability (GA) and under a current supportability/release package. Deprecated OS cannot be installed or utilized."

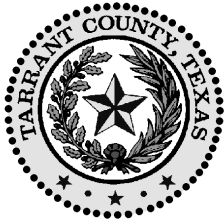
