COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Motorola Solutions, Inc. as sole source for Digital Evidence Data Migration, for the Sheriff's Office.

BACKGROUND

Motorola Solutions, Inc. provided the Purchasing Agent documentation that they are the sole provider of Motorola digital evidence data migration of existing Motorola/WatchGuard evidence data to the Evidence Library Cloud (EL). Motorola Solutions, Inc. currently hosts Tarrant County Sheriff's Department evidence data in a hybrid environment comprising both cloud and on-premise systems. Tarrant County intends to transition all evidence data storage from this hybrid configuration fully to the cloud to enhance operational efficiency and data management.

Under the County Purchasing Act, exemptions to the competitive bidding requirements are allowed for certain types of purchases. The statutes require that the Purchasing Agent advise the Commissioners Court of the existence of only one (1) source, with such notice to be entered into the minutes of the Court.

Accordingly, the above item has been determined to be sole source under the County Purchasing Act 262.024(a)(7) as follows:

- “(7) an item can be obtained from only one (1) source, including:
 - (A) items for which competition is precluded because of the existence of patents, copyrights, secret processes, or monopolies.”


