COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2023-133, Annual Contract for RFID Tracking Solution for Morgue Services, for the first optional twelve (12) month period at the same contract terms.

BACKGROUND

On March 5, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142763, awarded RFP No. 2023-133, Annual Contract for RFID Tracking Solution for Morgue Services, for the Medical Examiner's Office, to Superior Information Technologies, LLC d/b/a ANANTICS.

On November 19, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #144296, approved the consideration of Addendum 1 for RFP No. 2023-133, Annual Contract for RFID Tracking Solution for Morgue Services, for Medical Examiner's Office, to Superior Information Technologies, LLC d/b/a ANANTICS.

The award was based upon evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained options to renew for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods.

This contract will provide the Medical Examiner's Office with a system to support internal business processes aimed at removing the potential for human error in tracking the location, movement, and disposition of bodies processed within the County Medical Examiner morgue environment.

The vendor notified Purchasing in writing that they will extend the same contract terms through March 4, 2026. The Medical Examiner's Office notified Purchasing in writing that they are pleased with the vendor and want to renew.

Therefore, is the joint recommendation of the Medical Examiner's Office, Information Technology, and Purchasing that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2023-133, Annual Contract for RFID Tracking Solution for Morgue Services, for another twelve (12) month period.

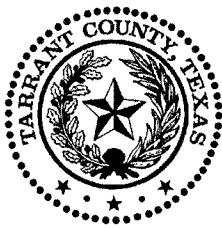
