**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider the destruction and sale as scrap metal for certain property donated or awarded to the Tarrant Regional Auto Crimes Task Force through forfeiture and judgement.

**BACKGROUND**

The following property was awarded to the Tarrant Regional Auto Crimes Task Force through forfeiture and judgement. Due to the general age and condition of the assets posing a potential safety risk to the public, staff requests to destroy and sell the property as scrap metal .

1989 GMC Sierra 1500 (white)  
2006 Harley Davidson FXDLI (black)  
2007 Harley Davidson V-Rod (frame/engine)

The following property was recovered stolen and acquired through donation by the Tarrant Regional Auto Crimes Task Force. Due to the condition of the property (stripped), the property owners donated the items through signed title and vehicle relinquishment letters to be destroyed. Therefore, staff requests to destroy and sell the property as scrap metal.

2003 Ford F250 (silver)  
2007 Dodge Ram 1500 (red – dismantled into multiple parts)

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Acceptance of the property will have no fiscal impact on the County's FY 2025 General Fund. The scrap metal proceeds will be deposited to the Tarrant Regional Auto Crimes Task Force program income account in the manner prescribed by the Texas Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority's Administrative Guidelines.
