**BACKGROUND**

On March 11, 2025, through Court Order #144905, the Commissioners Court appointed Patricia Burns as the Statutory Probate Judge of the Tarrant County Probate Court No. 1. The appointment was a result of this position being vacated by the current Probate Judge, Christopher Ponder and became effective on March 22, 2025. Ms. Burns accepted the appointment on March 21, 2025.

Patricia Burns was appointed to this position after former Probate Judge Christopher Ponder announced his resignation, effective March 21, 2025.
