SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO A HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM – AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN COMMITMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND DRC SOLUTIONS FOR THE PROVISION OF SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider an amendment to correct a clerical error to the HOME Investment Partnerships Program – American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) Commitment Agreement between Tarrant County and DRC Solutions for the provision of supportive services.

BACKGROUND

On November 19, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #144208, approved a contract with DRC Solutions to provide direct outreach services to assist eligible households. Under this agreement, DRC Solutions is reimbursed for eligible project delivery costs, not to exceed \$247,440.24.

Exhibit A – Program Summary included a table of eligible project delivery costs, which contained a clerical error in the "Supplies and Materials" line item. This amendment corrects that error by increasing the allowable amount for "Supplies and Materials" from \$15,000.00 to \$30,000.00. The total contract amount of \$247,440.24 remains unchanged.

The contract’s original execution date is unaffected by this amendment. All funds must be expended on eligible and approved costs within a two-year period.

This amendment has been reviewed and approved as to form by the Criminal District Attorney’s Office.

The original funding certified in the amount of \$247,440.24 is available through HOME-ARP grant #M21-DP480200.

**AMENDMENT #1 TO HOME-ARP COMMITMENT AGREEMENT FOR
SUPPORTIVE SERVICES**

This Amendment #1 is made and entered into by and between Tarrant County (the County) and DRC Solutions (DRC) and is effective as of the date of the last signature.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and DRC entered into a Subrecipient Agreement dated November 25, 2024, for the provision of essential supportive services under the HOME-American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) Program;

WHEREAS, the original agreement included Exhibit A – Program Summary, which outlines the project scope, funding amount, source of funds, term of agreement, and HOME-ARP Program Budget;

WHEREAS, the parties have identified an error in the Supplies and Materials line item of the HOME-ARP Program Budget and wish to amend Exhibit A to reflect the correct amount, without changing the total funding;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

AMENDMENT:

1. Exhibit A Program Summary is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Exhibit A – Program Summary – Amendment 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
2. The amendment corrects the line item “Supplies and Materials” from \$15,000.00 to \$30,000.00 and leaves the “Salary and Benefits Packages” line as originally granted, with the total program budget remaining at \$247,440.24.
3. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the original Subrecipient Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
