WHEREAS, Darryl Gamboa began his career with Tarrant County in November 1995 as one of two instructors to establish what was then known as the Data Services Software Training Center; and

WHEREAS, this Data Services Software Training Center is now Tarrant County Information Technology Department; and this department now serves more than 3,000 employees with information and storage management; and

WHEREAS, Darryl Gamboa helped to roll out ESS, Tarrant County's SAP self-service portal, by training county employees to use this system, a self-styled, "ESS Commando," as he served as one of the first county employees to navigate this new SAP application and then to teach all other employees its functions; and

WHEREAS, Darryl Gamboa has supported 6 different versions of the Windows operating system: Windows for Workgroups, Windows 95, Windows NT, Windows XP, Windows 7, Windows 10; and

WHEREAS, Darryl Gamboa, in 1998, also became Tarrant County's first remote desktop support technician, served four Precinct 2 Commissioners, working initially for Commissioner Marti Van Ravenswaay, then former Commissioners Andy Nguyen, Devan Allen and now, for Commissioner Alisa Simmons; and

WHEREAS, Darryl Gamboa has served his 29 years, 7 months and 8 days with an upbeat spirit, a smile on his face and joke ready to tell, always trying to bring a little joy to everyone he worked with.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County, do hereby celebrate Darryl Gamboa on his outstanding and meritorious service as Specialist, Customer Support Lead and extend best wishes upon his retirement.
