**SUBJECT: CONSIDER ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MPH IN THE
SOUTHFORK ESTATES SUBDIVISION, PHASES 1, 2, 3, & 4 - PRECINCT 1**

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider establishing a speed limit of 25 MPH in the Southfork Estates subdivision, phases 1, 2, 3, & 4, Precinct 1.

BACKGROUND

Citizen complaints regarding potential speeding initiated the need for a site visit and speed study to establish a posted speed limit for the Southfork Estates subdivision. The County Engineer has completed a speed study and recommends a maximum speed of 25 MPH be posted on all County maintained roads within the Southfork Estates subdivision, phases 1, 2, 3, & 4. This includes Fort Brown Trail (1405-041), Fort Crockett Trail (1405-020), Fort Belknap Trail (1405-010), Fort Croghan Trail (1405-100), Fort Elliott Trail (1405-110), Fort Teran Trail (1405-090, 1405-130 & 1405-160), Fort Ewell Trail (1405-150), Fort Cibolo Trail (1405-030), Fort Clark Trail (1405-050 & 1405-051), Fort Friffin Trail (1405-061), Fort Bird Trail (1405-080 & 1405-060), and Fort Gates Trail (1405-120 & 1405-070).

A public hearing was held by the Commissioners Court on January 28, 2025, pursuant to the Texas Transportation Code Section 251.152.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact to Tarrant County will be \$76.635 per sign for a total of \$1,915.75. Funding is available in account 26100-2025 Road and Bridge Fund / 6110300000 Precinct 1 Maintenance / 558041 Road Signs.
