BACKGROUND

Notice of the County’s intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Arlington Black Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Three hundred twenty-two (322) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this process. All documents pertaining to this bid were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested bidders. Four (4) bids were received.

The overall high bids received from the vendors listed above meet all specifications and are acceptable to Facilities Management.

The Facilities Management Department conducts the paper recycling program for the County. A number of other entities that have interlocal agreements with Tarrant County also participate in the program, resulting in a substantial increase in volume of material being handled. The purpose of this contract is for the sale of recyclable paper materials gathered from Tarrant County departmental offices.

Therefore, the recommendation that Bid No. F2025206, Sale of Recycled Paper for 20+ Tons of Sorted White Ledger, 40+ Tons of Sorted Office Paper, and 20+ Tons of Old Corrugated Cardboard, be awarded to the vendors listed above at the per unit price.
