**SUBJECT: BID NO. F2025011 - PURCHASE OF PURPOSE-BUILT BOOM MOWERS -
PRECINCTS 1 AND 4 - ATMAX EQUIPMENT CO. - PER UNIT PRICE**

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court award Bid No. F2025011, Purchase of Purpose-Built Boom Mowers, for Precincts 1 and 4, to ATMAX Equipment Co. at the per unit price.

BACKGROUND

Notice of the County's intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Arlington Black Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Eight hundred sixty-seven (867) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this bid process. All documents pertaining to this bid were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested bidders. A pre-bid conference held on October 16, 2024, was attended by three (3) vendors as well as representatives from Precincts 1 and 4 and Purchasing. Three (3) bids and nine (9) no-bids were received.

The bid received from Tellus Equipment Solutions, LLC did not meet specifications because they offered a machine with a horsepower of 143 instead of the required minimum of 150, they were unable to verify that the main boom arm was a minimum of nine (9) feet by seven (7) feet or that the outer boom arm was a minimum of five (5) and one-half feet by five (5) feet, and were unable to provide product specification sheets that include performance and dimensional information for the boom arms.

The low bid received from ATMAX Equipment Co. meets all specifications and is acceptable to Precincts 1 and 4.

The purpose of this bid is to purchase specialized equipment for mowing overhead tree lines that impede county roads, ravines, and ditches.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Precincts 1 and 4 and Purchasing that Bid No. F2025011, Purchase of Purpose-Built Boom Mowers, be awarded to ATMAX Equipment Co. at the per unit price.

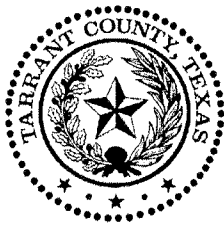
