**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider Amendment No. 1 for RFP No. F2025129, Annual Contract for Notary Fraud Alert Software and Maintenance, for the County Clerk's Office, with Fidlar Technologies.

**BACKGROUND**

On May 20, 2025, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #145265, awarded RFP No. F2025129, Annual Contract for Notary Fraud Alert Software and Maintenance, for the County Clerk's Office, to Fidlar Technologies.

Amendment No. 1 is to reduce the total contract value due to Fidlar Technologies' failure to deliver the full suite of marketing services, including roll-out and beta testing. Amendment No. 1 reflects a mutually agreed price reduction to account for these deficiencies and aligns the contract with actual deliverables provided.

Amendment No. 1 is attached for approval and signature. The District Attorney's Office reviewed Amendment No. 1 as to form.

**PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT-FIRST AMENDMENT TO

“One-Time charge for NFA licensing, set-up and collateral materials: \$100,000.00 – 50% (\$50,000) Due upon signing and 50% (\$50,000) due upon completion of User Acceptance.

and replaced with:

“One-Time charge for NFA licensing, set-up and collateral materials: \$50,000.00 – 50% (\$25,000) Due upon signing and 50% (\$25,000) due upon completion of User Acceptance.”

All other terms and conditions of the PSA remain unchanged.

statutes and regulations, and non-discrimination laws and regulations. Vendor shall be responsible for ensuring its compliance with any laws and regulations applicable to its business, including maintaining any necessary licenses and permits.

## **NFA Termination:**

The license granted under this agreement, with regard to the software, may be terminated by either party for material failure to comply with terms and conditions of this agreement or as a matter of convenience, upon written notice of Thirty (30) days. The term of this agreement is One-Year with two (2) optional Twelve (12) month periods. The Agreement will auto renew for successive one-year terms unless terminated by either party with 30 day written notice. Following the initial three-year period, the annual maintenance and support rate will increase at a rate of 3% year over year. The parties acknowledge and agree that Tarrant County is a governmental entity subject to yearly funding limitations and Vendor agrees County may terminate this Agreement during any future fiscal years in which funding is not allocated by the Commissioner's Court for services/products covered under this Agreement.

## **NFA Service Fees:**

One-Time charge for NFA licensing, set-up and collateral materials: ~~\$100,000.00~~

- 50% (\$50,000) Due upon signing and 50% (\$50,000) due upon completion of User Acceptance

Annual Maintenance and Support (Fixed for three (3) years): ~~\$25,000.00~~

- Due upon live date

Annual support includes the NFA services described herein and in Addendum A.

**Ad-Hoc Professional Services and Development      \$150 per Labor Hour**

Services not to Exceed \$150,000 during the period of this agreement

**Payment of the 50% Balance total fees for services rendered by Fidler Technologies shall be due upon completion of User Acceptance Testing (UAT) and receipt of written approval from the County. Fidler will provide written notice to the County when UAT is complete. Upon receipt of this notice, the County shall have five (5) business days to provide written approval (via email is acceptable) confirming that the services have performed to the County's satisfaction. The County may only reject the deliverables if they fail to materially conform to the agreed upon specifications set forth in the Statement of Work (SOW). If the county does not provide written approval or documented concerns regarding the services within this timeframe, the services shall be deemed accepted by the County. All payments are due according to the Texas Prompt Payment Act, upon County's written approval.**
