**SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION TO DEACCESSION ITEMS FROM THE CITY OF
FORT WORTH AVIATION DEPARTMENT COLLECTION OF THE
TARRANT COUNTY ARCHIVES**

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider authorizing the deaccession of select materials from the City of Fort Worth Aviation Department Collection maintained by the Tarrant County Archives. Deaccessioned materials will be considered for donation, auction, or other disposition in accordance with established archival policies and procedures.

BACKGROUND

The City of Fort Worth Aviation Department Collection was accessioned into the Tarrant County Archives in 2014. The collection consists of over 5,000 items including artifacts, books, technical manuals, training aids, textbooks, magazines, A/V materials, photographs, posters, artwork, personal memorabilia from individuals associated with north Texas aviation, and exhibit displays.

On October 11, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #139334, approved the deaccession and donation of two (2) large interactive exhibit displays from this same collection to the Fort Worth Aviation Museum.

A recent review determined that a substantial portion of the collection should be deaccessioned. Items identified for removal include:

- Materials with no additional research value.
- Duplicate materials.
- Items outside the Archives' collecting scope, such as Audio/Visual recordings of popular movies and television shows, publications that are not aviation related, and large quantities of model building magazines.
- Large quantities of readily available maintenance manuals, user guides, and model-building magazines.
- Materials unsuitable for long-term preservation, including items with mold damage.

The collection also contains over 2,300 books, both related and unrelated to aviation history. Due to space limitations, lack of public browsing access, and the absence of an online catalog, the Archives is not an ideal repository for the majority of these volumes. A curated selection of books, including directories for military aviation organizations and those directly related to the history of aviation in Fort Worth will be retained. Remaining titles will be offered to partner institutions, including the Fort Worth Public Library, the Fort Worth History Center, and the Fort Worth Aviation Museum, which have expressed interest in adding select books into their holdings.

The Fort Worth City Council approved the donation of the City of Fort Worth Historic Aviation Collection on March 18, 2014.

This collection includes items related to the aviation history of Fort Worth and North Texas. In all, the collection represents over 5,000 items, including artifacts, books, aircraft and engine technical manuals and data, aviation training aids and related materials, textbooks, aviation magazines, video tape and film media, photographs, posters, original artwork, and personal memorabilia of individuals associated with North Texas aviation. Dated material ranges from the 1940s to the early 2000s. The collection also includes some of the items from the "Ascent...When Dreams Defy Gravity" exhibit that was created for the Museum of Science and History in 2010.

The City believes that by donating the collection to the Tarrant County Archive, we will ensure the collection is preserved for future generations to explore.
