

***A resolution honoring Amanda Jane Arizola for her groundbreaking service on the Tarrant County Hospital District Board of Managers***

**WHEREAS**, the Tarrant County Hospital District Board of Managers was formed with a mission to transform healthcare delivery to Tarrant County communities and with a vision to become a national leader in improving patient experiences, medical outcomes and access to care; and

**WHEREAS**, two of the values of Tarrant County Hospital District's Board of Managers are *Mutual Respect*, which includes honoring "the ideas, beliefs and diversity of others"; and *Excellence*, which includes striving "to exceed expectations by establishing high standards of performance"; and

**WHEREAS**, during her tenure, *Amanda Arizola* also co-chaired the Quality Committee, where she strengthened JPS's commitment to indigent families and low-income patients; and

**WHEREAS**, through her unwavering service, *Amanda Arizola* has left an enduring legacy that will continue to shape the future of public health in Tarrant County.
