COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider Amendment No. 2 for Bid No. 2023-123, Annual Contract for Urine, Hair Follicle, Nail, and Sweat Patch Drug Testing, for Juvenile Services, with Close to Home Holdings, LLC d/b/a Integrity Health & Education at the per contract terms.

BACKGROUND

On September 19, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #141765, awarded Bid No. 2023-123, Annual Contract for Urine, Hair Follicle, Nail, and Sweat Patch Drug Testing, for Juvenile Services, to Close to Home Holdings, LLC d/b/a Integrity Health & Education.

The award was based upon low bid meeting specifications and contained options to renew for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods.

On January 23, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142507, approved Amendment No. 1.

On October 1, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #144024, approved the first renewal option.

The Juvenile Court requires all youth on court-ordered supervision in the community to be drug tested at arrest. The Court, at its discretion, orders youth to undergo hair follicle, nail, and sweat patch drug testing. Urine drug tests are routinely utilized by juvenile probation officers to monitor probationers' substance use and compliance with court orders.

Amendment No. 2 revises Section 4.1 of the original contract by increasing the total not-to-exceed amount of the contract from \$78,275.00 to \$85,275.00, an increase of \$7,000.00.

Amendment No. 2 is attached for approval and signature. The District Attorney's Office reviewed this contract as to form.

2. Revises contract increasing the total cost of Urine Standard Panel test from \$52.50 to \$53.00.


The COUNTY will pay PROVIDER no more than an amount of \$85,275 annually.

of the contract period.



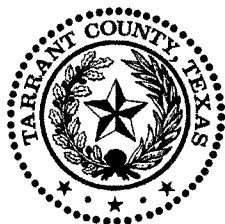
