COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider Addendum for Information Technology Subscription Based Research and Related Services, utilizing the State of Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract #DIR-CPO-5253, for Human Resources, with Gartner, Inc. at the per contract terms.

BACKGROUND

On January 28, 2025, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #144657, considered the use of subscription-based research and related services from Gartner, Inc. through the State of Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract #DIR-CPO-5253.

Gartner, Inc. is a research and advisory provider of industry-leading, technology-related insight, guidance, and tools to enable information technology professionals to make informed business decisions. The subscription-based services provide key, on-demand deliverables such as diagnostic tools, templates, and case studies; selected vendor reports, and inquiry calls with Gartner research experts.

The current request will permit the Human Resources Department to utilize the research experts and advisory tools of the market industry to provide guidance and tools to improve employee recruitment, employee experiences, and build skilled leaders.

The term of the contract is effective September 1, 2025, with two (2) options for renewal periods of twelve (12) months each.

The Addendum is attached for approval and signature. The District Attorney's Office reviewed the contract as to form.

**Addendum to
DIR Contract No. DIR-CPO-5253**

This Addendum ("Addendum") is effective 9/1/2025 and is between Tarrant County with an address of 100 E. Weatherford St., Suite 501, Fort Worth, TX 76196 ("Customer") and **Gartner, Inc.** with an address of 56 Top Gallant Road, Stamford, CT 06904 ("Vendor").

WHEREAS, Customer and Vendor are entering into a contract as evidenced by that certain Quote #**1-2L6V9HRJ** dated September 1, 2025 (the "Quote"), which incorporates DIR Contract No. DIR-CPO-5253 (the "DIR Contract") between the State of Texas, acting by and through the Department of Information Resources, and Vendor, as amended from time to time (collectively with the Quote and this Addendum, the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Customer and Vendor desire to amend certain provisions of the Quote and the DIR Contract;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the representations and mutual undertakings hereinafter set forth, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Governing Terms. The DIR Contract, the Quote and this Addendum shall govern this purchase.
2. Jurisdiction; Venue. Any legal action arising out of or relating to the Agreement shall be brought only in the state or federal courts located in Tarrant County, Texas, and the parties irrevocably consent to the jurisdiction and venue of such courts.
3. Boycott of Israel Prohibited. In compliance with Section 2271.001 et seq. of the Texas Government Code, Vendor verifies that neither it nor any of its affiliates currently boycott Israel and neither it nor any of its affiliates will boycott Israel during the term of this Agreement.
4. Scrutinized Business Operations Prohibited. In compliance with Section 2252.151 et seq. of the Texas Government Code, Vendor warrants and represents that: (1) neither Vendor nor any of its affiliates engages in scrutinized business operations in Sudan; (2) neither Vendor nor any of its affiliates engages in scrutinized business operations in Iran; and (3) neither Vendor nor any of its affiliates engages in scrutinized business operations with designated foreign terrorist organizations. Vendor further represents and warrants that neither Vendor nor any of its affiliates appears on any of the Texas Comptroller's Scrutinized Companies Lists.
5. Discrimination against Firearm Entities or Firearm Trade Associations Prohibited. In compliance with Section 2274.002 of the Texas Government Code (added by 87th Legislature, S.B. 19), Vendor verifies that neither it nor any of its affiliates have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association; and neither it nor any of its affiliates will discriminate during the term of the Agreement against a firearm entity or firearm trade association.
6. Boycott of Energy Companies Prohibited. In compliance with Section 2276.002 of the Texas Government Code, Vendor verifies that neither it nor any of its affiliates boycott energy companies and neither it nor any of its affiliates will boycott energy companies during the term of this Agreement.
7. Compliance with Laws. In providing the services required by this Agreement, Vendor must observe and comply with all applicable federal, state, and local statutes, ordinances, rules, and regulations, including, without limitation, workers' compensation laws, minimum and maximum salary and wage statutes and regulations, and non-discrimination laws and regulations. Vendor shall be responsible for ensuring its compliance with any laws and regulations applicable to its business, including maintaining any necessary licenses and permits.
8. Execution of Agreement. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which will be deemed to be an original copy of this Agreement, and all of which, when taken together, shall be deemed to constitute one and the same agreement. The exchange of copies of this Agreement and of signature pages by electronic transmission shall constitute effective execution and delivery of this Agreement as to the parties and may be used in lieu of the original Agreement for all purposes. Signatures of the parties transmitted or executed electronically shall be deemed to be their original signatures for any purpose whatsoever.

3. **Modification of Services by Vendor.** In order to remain current and timely in its Service offerings, Vendor may make minor improvements from time to time in the content of any Service. If Vendor discontinues any Service in its entirety, Customer may, at its option, receive a substitute Service, or obtain a pro rata refund of the fees paid for the discontinued Service.
4. **Licensed User** is the individual named in the Customer Purchase Order who is licensed to use the Services. Customer will limit access to the Services to the agreed upon number of Licensed Users.
5. **Ownership and Use of the Services.** Vendor owns and retains all rights to the Services not expressly granted to Customer. Only the individuals named in the Customer Purchase Order (each a "**Licensed User**") may access the Services. Each Licensed User will be issued a unique password, which may not be shared. Upon request, Customer agrees to provide Vendor with assurance from a responsible party (or other relevant evidence) of compliance with these usage terms.
8. **DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES.** EXCEPT AS PROVIDED BY THE DIR CONTRACT, THE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED ON AN "AS IS" BASIS, AND VENDOR EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, STATUTORY OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR AS TO ACCURACY, COMPLETENESS OR ADEQUACY OF INFORMATION. CUSTOMER RECOGNIZES THE UNCERTAINTIES INHERENT IN ANY ANALYSIS OR INFORMATION THAT MAY BE PROVIDED AS PART OF THE SERVICES AND ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE SERVICES ARE NOT A SUBSTITUTE FOR ITS OWN INDEPENDENT EVALUATION AND ANALYSIS AND SHOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED A RECOMMENDATION TO PURSUE ANY COURSE OF ACTION. VENDOR SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY ACTIONS OR DECISIONS THAT CUSTOMER MAY TAKE BASED ON THE SERVICES OR ANY INFORMATION OR DATA CONTAINED THEREIN.
9. **Applicable Law.** This SA shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the procedural and substantive laws of the State of Texas, without reference to its conflict of law principles, venue for disputes shall be Travis County, Texas.
10. **Customer Confidential Information.** To the extent allowable under the Texas Public Information Act, Vendor agrees to keep confidential any Customer-specific information communicated by Customer to Vendor that is (i) clearly marked confidential if provided in written form, or (ii) preceded by a statement that such information is confidential, if provided in oral form, and such statement is confirmed in writing within 15 days of its initial disclosure. This obligation of confidence shall not apply to any information that: (1) is in the public domain at the time of its communication; (2) is independently developed by Vendor; (3) entered the public domain through no fault of Vendor subsequent to Customer's communication to Vendor; (4) is in Vendor's possession free of any obligation of confidence at the time of Customer's communication to Vendor; or (5) is communicated by the Customer to a third party free of any obligation of confidence. Additionally, Vendor may disclose such

information to the extent required by legal process. Customer acknowledges that Vendor is in the business of researching and analyzing information technology and this obligation of confidence shall not apply to information obtained by Vendor's research, analysis or consulting organization(s) from other sources.
