COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with My Health My Resources of Tarrant County (MHMR) for the Tarrant County Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) program as part of the Tarrant County Fiscal Recovery Funds program.

BACKGROUND

On January 18, 2022, through Court Order #137258, the Commissioners Court approved an ILA with MHMR to operate the Tarrant County AOT program as part of the County's ARPA Fiscal Recovery Fund program.

On September 20, 2022, through Court Order #139145, the Commissioners Court approved the First Amendment to the ILA with MHMR for the AOT program. The First Amendment extended the term of the agreement to December 31, 2024, and modified the program budget to allow for eligible indirect costs. The program budget was not increased.

With approval of the Second Amendment, the term of the ILA will be extended to September 30, 2025, and the total program budget will be increased from \$2,400,000 to \$3,400,000 to fund an additional year of program operation.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed and approved this ILA as to form.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding in the amount of \$1,000,000 is available in CARPA-2025.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND MY HEALTH MY RESOURCES OF TARRANT COUNTY TO OPERATE THE TARRANT COUNTY ASSISTED OUTPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAM

Tarrant County (the “County”) and My Health My Resources of Tarrant County (the “Subrecipient”), each a “Party” and collectively the “Parties” to an Interlocal Agreement related to the use of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (“FRF Funds”) dated January 18, 2022 (the “Agreement”) and first amended on September 20, 2022, now wish to further amend the Agreement. This Amendment is effective upon the signature of the Parties:

WHEREAS, on February January 18, 2022, through Court Order No. 137258, the County approved the Agreement with Subrecipient; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2022, through Court Order No. 139145, the County approved the First Amendment to the Agreement with Subrecipient; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to extend the Agreement and provide additional funds to allow Subrecipient to continue operation of the Assisted Outpatient Treatment program; and

WHEREAS, the Subrecipient wishes to continue providing services under the Assisted Outpatient Treatment program as outlined in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Subrecipient and County will continue to make payments or performance required by the Agreement and this Amendment from revenues legally available.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Term of the Agreement shall be extended to September 30, 2025.
2. The County shall increase the Agreement funding amount from \$2,400,000.00 to \$3,400,000.00.
3. Appendix B shall be modified as included herein.
4. Except as modified by this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in effect.




