**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2023-109, Annual Contract for Defendant-Paid Ignition Interlock Device Services, for the first optional twelve (12) month period at the same contract terms.

**BACKGROUND**

On August 1, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #141394, awarded RFP No. 2023-109, Annual Contract for Defendant-Paid Ignition Interlock Device Services, for Community Supervision and Corrections Department (CSCD), to the following vendors:

Primary	Global IID Parent, LLC, d/b/a 1A Smart Start, LLC
Secondary	Consumer Safety Technology, LLC

The awards were based upon evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained options to renew for three (3) additional twelve (12) month periods.

The ignition interlock device is a small, handheld breathalyzer installed in vehicles to prevent individuals under the influence of alcohol from operating a motor vehicle. It requires the driver to provide a breath sample before the engine can start. CSCD utilizes ignition interlock device services to ensure compliance and promote public safety for probationers and parolees convicted of alcohol-related offenses.

The vendors notified Purchasing in writing that they will extend the same contract terms through August 31, 2026. CSCD notified Purchasing in writing that they are pleased with the vendors and want to renew.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of CSCD and Purchasing that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2023-109, Annual Contract for Defendant-Paid Ignition Interlock Device Services, for another twelve (12) month period.

Services are paid for by offenders/defendants. No Tarrant County funds are required.

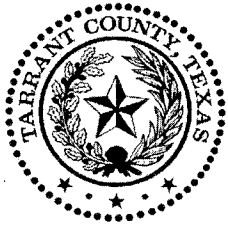
