**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2022-137A, Annual Contract for Offender/Defendant-Paid Batterer’s Intervention and Prevention Program and High-Risk Batterer’s Intervention and Prevention Program, for the second optional twelve (12) month period at the same contract terms.

**BACKGROUND**

On September 6, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #139052, awarded RFP No. 2022-137A, Annual Contract for Offender/Defendant-Paid Batterer’s Intervention and Prevention Program and High-Risk Batterer’s Intervention and Prevention Program, for Community Supervision and Corrections Department (CSCD), to the following vendors:

The awards were based upon evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained options to renew for three (3) additional twelve (12) month periods.

On March 19, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142843, approved the first renewal option.

This program is essential for ensuring court-mandated offenders receive the necessary intervention to prevent domestic violence and reduce recidivism. This program also provides structured counseling and education to individuals convicted of domestic violence offenses, helping them take accountability for their actions and develop healthier behavior patterns. The high-risk component specifically addresses offenders who pose a greater threat, ensuring they receive targeted interventions to reduce the likelihood of repeat offenses.
