SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION OF AN AMENDED WEBDEALER MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY, D/B/A TARRANT COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR AND THE CITY OF FORT WORTH TO PROCESS MOTOR VEHICLE TITLES AND REGISTRATIONS

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve the amended webDealer Motor Vehicle License Agreement between Tarrant County, d/b/a Tarrant County Tax Assessor-Collector and the City of Fort Worth to process Motor Vehicle Titles and Registrations.

BACKGROUND

The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TXDMV) uses web-based systems known as WebDealer and WebSub to allow entities to process titles and motor vehicle registrations electronically.

These agreements provide the Tarrant County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office the authority to grant dealerships access to the WebDealer system for title and registration processing, and subcontractors access to WebSub registration processing. These agreements also cover the necessary supplies required to process titles and registrations electronically, improving efficiency and saving time for the Tarrant County Tax Office.

On May 20, 2025, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #145296, approved the original agreement with the City of Fort Worth to process Motor Vehicle Titles and Registrations.

With approval of this Amendment, the City of Fort Worth will add two (2) additional locations. The term of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect until January 31, 2029, unless superseded or amended by a written instrument executed by each party.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has approved these agreements as to form.

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.
