COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of Groupware Technologies, LLC as sole source for HIV-AIDS Client Eligibility and Management System, for HIV Administrative Agency.

BACKGROUND

On February 21, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142688, approved Groupware Technologies, LLC as sole source for HIV-AIDS Client Eligibility and Management System.

Groupware Technologies, LLC provided the Purchasing Agent documentation to substantiate that their sole source status has not changed for the Provide Enterprise Care Management software system and support services. The program was developed by and is the sole property of Groupware Technologies, LLC and they do not have any third-party resellers or certified support providers. All licenses, maintenance, and support for this program utilized by HIV Administrative Agency are available only through Groupware Technologies, LLC.

Groupware Technologies, LLC is an independent software vendor specializing in the design, distribution, and support of its proprietary care management software, Provide Enterprise (PE). The HIV Administrative Agency and subrecipients use PE to manage all aspects of Ryan White grant funding, including budgets, billing, client-level data tracking, and reporting.

Under the County Purchasing Act, exemptions to the competitive bidding requirements are allowed for certain types of purchases. The statutes require that the Purchasing Agent advise the Commissioners Court of the existence of only one (1) source, with such notice to be entered into the minutes of the Court.

Accordingly, the above item has been determined to be sole source under the County Purchasing Act 262.024(a) (7) as follows:

- "(7) an item can be obtained from only one (1) source, including:
 - (A) items for which competition is precluded because of the existence of patents, copyrights, secret processes, or monopolies;"
