COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that Commissioners Court consider a letter agreement between Tarrant County and the City of Dallas to accept federal grant funding for the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.

BACKGROUND

On October 25, 2005, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #96691, approved the original agreement to participate with the City of Dallas in the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force. Through subsequent orders, the Commissioners Court approved the continuation of participation with the City of Dallas in the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force and acceptance of grant funding.

With approval of this agreement, the Criminal District Attorney's office will continue its participation with the City of Dallas in the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force and accept supplemental grant funding in the amount of \$16,000.00. The supplemental grant funding will reimburse Tarrant County for expenses incurred for equipment, travel, training, overtime, and undercover expenses, as deemed necessary and appropriate by the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office, for its operations to combat internet crimes against children within its jurisdiction.

The term of the agreement is October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has approved the Letter Agreement as to form.
