**a. Annual Contract for Grease, Lint, Oil, and Sand Trap Cleaning Services**

Estimated Value - \$82,210.00

Funding has been requested in the FY 2026 budget.

This contract is to clean out and dispose of liquid waste accumulated in grease and sand traps located at various Tarrant County facilities. This contract will be used by Facilities Management and the primary contact is Joshua Palmer.

**b. Annual Contract for Arbor and Landscape Supplies and Services**

Estimated Value - \$273,820.00

Funding has been requested in the FY 2026 budget.

This contract is for landscaping projects and maintenance services at various Tarrant County locations. This contract will be used by Facilities Management and the primary contact is Joshua Palmer.

**c. Annual Contract for Irrigation Supplies, Services, and Repairs**

Estimated Value - \$388,790.00

**d. Annual Contract for Specialized Electrical Services**

Funding has been requested in the FY 2026 budget.

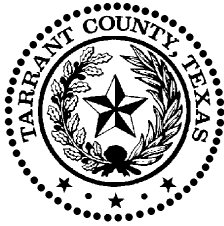
