**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PUBLIC HEARING – WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3, 2025, 10:00 A.M. – TO CONSIDER ESTABLISHING TWO SCHOOL ZONES WITHIN THE CROWLEY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT - PRECINCT 2**

**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, September 3, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. to consider establishing two school zones within the Crowley Independent School District (ISD) in Precinct 2. The public hearing will provide an opportunity for public input, after which the Court may take action to authorize the school zones.

**BACKGROUND**

Transportation Services has coordinated with the Crowley ISD to evaluate two (2) locations for new school zones. The first location serves a new school situated on the southeast corner of the intersection of Floyd Hampton Road and Pont Du Gard Way. The second location serves an existing school located on the northeast corner of the intersection of McCart Avenue and McDonald Drive. Establishing these school zones requires a Court Order passed by the Commissioners Court.

**Recommended School Zones:**

A 20 MPH School Zone is requested on Floyd Hampton Road (CR.1111-010), Pont Du Gard Way (CR.1304-020), and Sydney Harbour Drive (CR.1304-030).

A 20 MPH School Zone is requested on McCart Avenue (CR.1402-060) and McDonald Drive (1402-070).

Tarrant County intends to conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, September 3, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. in the G.K. Maenius Administration Building, Commissioners Courtroom, 5th Floor, 100 E. Weatherford Street, Fort Worth, Texas 76196. In the event the Tarrant County Commissioners Courtroom in the G.K. Maenius Administration Building is inaccessible to the public due to construction and renovations on September 3, 2025, the public hearing and the regularly scheduled Tarrant County Commissioners Court meeting will take place at the Charles J. Murray Courtroom, Tom Vandergriff Civil Courts Building, 100 N. Calhoun Street, 2nd Floor, Fort Worth, Texas 76196. If the alternative location at the Tom Vandergriff Civil Courts Building is used, notice will be posted at the entrance of the G.K. Maenius Administration Building informing the public.
