

*A resolution recognizing the extensive public service and valued contributions  
of Tarrant County Human Services Director Lisa Love Martin*

**WHEREAS**, *Lisa Love Martin began serving Tarrant County Department of Human Services on April 1, 1992, initially as a Social Worker I; and later rose through the ranks by serving with distinction and unwavering commitment, to become director; and,*

**WHEREAS**, *Lisa Martin, developed processes and procedures that led to greater government efficiency, including an in-person, check pick-up system for landlords, which reduced the high rate of payments lost in the mail; a Paperless Voucher System and Amazon Business Giving and,*

**WHEREAS**, *Lisa Martin initiated community relationships, including with Tarrant Area Food Bank, to allow on-site application for SNAP Food Benefits, thereby reducing transportation barriers and leading to improved health outcomes for children and families; and*

**WHEREAS**, *Lisa Martin implemented new office practices, such as installing a lobby display for educational pamphlets; a touch-screen in the Human Services conference room for training and an electronic Case Management System for digital record-keeping; all which enhanced service delivery and fostered a positive work culture; and,*

**WHEREAS**, *Ms. Martin has worked on many internal and community committees to create solutions for homelessness and utility disconnections; and, most recently, she led the county during a crisis and developed the Disposition of Deceased Paupers Policy; now,*

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *that we, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County, do hereby recognize Lisa Love Martin for her outstanding achievements and congratulate her upon her retirement on May 31, 2025 after 33 years of significant contribution to the growth, development, and success of Tarrant County's Department of Human Services.*
