COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court award Bid No. F2025061, Purchase of Full Matrix Message Boards, for Precincts 1 and 4, to Superior Traffic Control, LLC at the per unit price.

BACKGROUND

Notice of the County's intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Arlington Black Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Three hundred fourteen (314) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this bid process. All documents pertaining to this bid were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested bidders. Eight (8) bids and two (2) no-bids were received.

The bid received from RoadSafe Traffic Systems did not meet specifications because their warranty repair servicing center is not within 50 miles of 100 E. Weatherford St. Fort Worth, TX 76196, as required per bid specifications.

The low bid received from Superior Traffic Control, LLC meets specifications and is acceptable to Precincts 1 and 4.

The purpose of this purchase is for traffic control and to alert drivers of upcoming changes during road projects in Tarrant County. This will be purchased by Precincts 1 and 4.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Precincts 1 and 4 and Purchasing that Bid No. F2025061, Purchase of Full Matrix Message Boards, be awarded to Superior Traffic Control, LLC at the per unit price.


