**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider accepting donations from the Arlington Fire Department for the Tarrant County Public Health (TCPH) Department.

**BACKGROUND**

The Arlington Fire Department opened a vaccine clinic during the pandemic to help with vaccine immunity across Tarrant County. The Arlington Fire Department purchased a vaccine refrigerator, vaccine freezer, and a pallet of gloves. These medical grade appliances are registered with the Department of Health and Human services (DSHS) to hold vaccines as a part of the Vaccines for Children and Adult Safety Net programs.

The TCPH's Immunization program provides Immunizations services to families across Tarrant County through brick-and-mortar clinics, outreach and mobile community events and will use these donations as a part of these services.

The Arlington Fire Department has donated these items to TCPH Immunization program at no cost. Estimated value for all donated items is \$12,143.04.

With approval, the one (1) time donation of supplies, as mentioned above will be distributed to all Immunization Clinics, Mobile and Outreach Teams.
