COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court accept payment bond for Bid No. 2023-139, Annual Contract for C-Cure Access Control System Maintenance, Repair and Equipment Purchase, for Facilities Management, with EMC Integrated Systems, for \$59,873.72.

BACKGROUND

On July 11, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #141210, awarded Bid No. 2023 139, Annual Contract for C-Cure Access Control System Maintenance, Repair, and Equipment Purchase, for Facilities Management, to the following vendors:

Secondary	ADT Commercial
Alternate	Paladin Technologies, Inc.

On May 21, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #143174, approved the first renewal option.

The proposal received from EMC Integrated Systems Group meets all specifications and is acceptable to Facilities Management.

EMC Integrated Systems Group will provide all labor, materials, and equipment for repairing or installing additional access control devices across the G.K. Maenius Administration Building, Mansfield Subcourthouse, Southwest Subcourthouse, Miller Subcourthouse, Northeast Subcourthouse, Arlington Subcourthouse, and Northwest Subcourthouse.

A payment bond is part of the requirement for the contractor to begin work. The bond is required solely for the protection of all claimants supplying labor or furnishing materials used on this project.

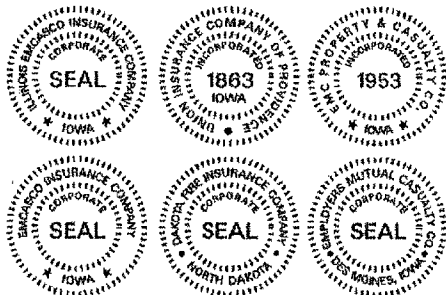
AUTHORITY FOR POWER OF ATTORNEY
