COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider Amendment No. 1 for HSCloud Suite Application, for Public Health, with HS GovTech d/b/a HealthSpace USA.

BACKGROUND

On July 2, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #143426, approved the contract for the HSCloud Suite Application, for Public Health, with HS GovTech d/b/a HealthSpace USA.

On July 1, 2025, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #145513, approved the first option for renewal.

Amendment No. 1 modifies the term of the Agreement by removing the fixed twelve (12) month term with optional annual renewals. The revised language provides that the agreement shall remain in effect unless terminated in accordance with the provisions of the agreement, replacing the previous annual renewal structure.

Second, Amendment No. 1 updates Appendix C - Fees Section (b) to reflect the current licensing and support fee structure. The updated language establishes a yearly fee for license, hosting, maintenance, and technical support, due annually beginning July 1, 2024, and on each anniversary thereafter. Following July 1, 2029, a 3% annual Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) will be applied to each subsequent year's fee.

Amendment No. 1 is attached for approval and signature. The District Attorney's Office reviewed Amendment No. 1 as to form.

Contract Amendment

HS Cloud Suite for Tarrant County Public Health

This contract amendment is to amend the terms of the original contract:

- Section 6 (a) of the original contract will be amended from “The term of this Agreement will be for twelve (12) months with the option to renew four (4) additional twelve (12) month periods.” to “The agreement shall remain in effect unless terminated in accordance with the provisions of the agreement.”
- Appendix C - Fees Section (b) bullet three will be amended to: “Yearly license, hosting, maintenance, and technical support (\$34,293.00) due July 1, 2024 and on the anniversary thereof after. Upon expiration of the original contract term on June 30, 2029, a 3% annual Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) shall be applied each year to the license fees, continuing annually until the termination of this agreement.”

All other terms and conditions are subject to the original contract agreement dated July 2, 2024.

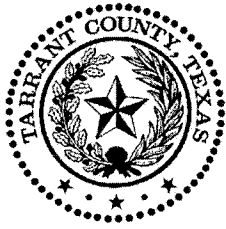
