COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider use of cooperative for Subscription Agreement for Correctional Enterprise, utilizing the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract #DIR-CPO-5258, for the Sheriff's Office, with Thomson Reuters and approve contract.

BACKGROUND

One (1) vendor who offers Correctional Enterprise was contacted and required to provide a written quotation. The quote from Thomson Reuters meets all requirements and is acceptable to the Sheriff's Office.

The term of this agreement is effective November 1, 2025, through October 31, 2028 and includes the ability for either party to terminate the agreement when notice is provided sixty (60) days prior to termination. The agreement also includes an annual four percent (4%) price increase.

The purpose of this purchase is to provide access to legal research materials for inmates in correctional facilities. This satisfies federal and state requirements for inmate access to legal research materials.

The DIR contract expires September 20, 2029.

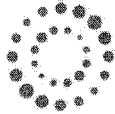

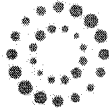
