COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court award Bid No. F2024179, Resource Connection Multiple Buildings Switchboard Replacement, for Facilities Management, to CEC Facilities Group, LLC, for \$462,734.00, approve contract and accept bonds.

BACKGROUND

Notice of the County’s intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Arlington Black Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Five hundred sixty-four (564) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this bid process. All documents pertaining to this bid were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested bidders. No vendors attended the pre-bid conference held on August 27, 2024. One (1) bid and eight (8) no-bids were received.

The bid received from CEC Facilities Group, LLC meets all specifications and is acceptable to Facilities Management.

The purpose of this contract is to replace and upgrade the exterior electrical switchboards at Buildings 1200, 1300, 1400, 2100, 2200 Circle Drive, and 5051 Resource Drive. Current switchboards are at the end of their service life having been installed originally in 1974.

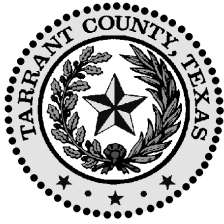
