COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider the submission of the Fiscal Year 2025 Formula Grant Application and Resolution to the Texas Indigent Defense Commission (TIDC) Indigent Defense Grant Program.

BACKGROUND

The TIDC provides financial and technical support to counties to develop and maintain quality, cost effective indigent defense systems that meet the needs of local communities and the requirements of the Constitution and state law. Formula grants are awarded to eligible Texas counties to help meet the needs of constitutional and statutory requirements for indigent defense and to promote compliance with standards adopted by the TIDC. Attorney's fees, investigatory and witness expenditures, and other litigation expenses paid by the county on behalf of indigent criminal defendants and juvenile respondents are allowable.

The amount each county is eligible to receive is based upon the respective county's FY 2024 baseline amount spent on indigent representation. The grant award for FY 2024 was \$966,517.00.

The grant application deadline is November 15, 2024. The grant period for reimbursable expenses is from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025.

The Budget and Risk Management Department has reviewed the grant application.

There are no indirect costs, match or operating subsidy associated with this grant application.


WHEREAS, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and
