COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of Bid No. F2024077, Annual Contract for Ground-Based Mosquito Control and Surveillance Activities, for the first optional twelve (12) month period at the same firm fixed prices.

BACKGROUND

On May 21, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #143158, awarded Bid No. F2024077, Annual Contract for Ground-Based Mosquito Control and Surveillance Activities, for Public Health, to the following vendors:

Primary PRP Services LLC d/b/a Municipal Mosquito
Secondary Vector Disease Control International (VDCI)

The awards were based upon low bid meeting specifications and contained options to renew for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods.

The purpose of this contract is to allow an integrated mosquito management approach via chemical control to reduce disease-carrying mosquitos in unincorporated areas of Tarrant County.

The vendors notified Purchasing in writing that their prices will remain firm through June 4, 2026. Public Health notified Purchasing in writing that they are pleased with the vendors and want to renew.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Public Health and Purchasing that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of Bid No. F2024077, Annual Contract for Ground-Based Mosquito Control and Surveillance Activities, for another twelve (12) month period.

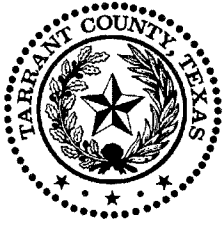
