COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider Amendment No. 1 to the Integrated Child Support System Cooperative Agreement between Tarrant County and the Office of the Attorney General.

BACKGROUND

On September 14, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #136317, approved the Integrated Child Support System Cooperative Agreement between Tarrant County and the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas to provide the citizens of Tarrant County with comprehensive, effective, and efficient child, medical and dental support enforcement services at a local level.

Amendment No. 1 revises the contract language referencing the current IRS tax code and reorganizes the language of provision 7.2.3 from one (1) subpart into three (3) subparts. All performance requirements and obligations remain in full force and effect.

This amendment has been approved as to form by the Criminal District Attorney's Office.

**AMENDMENT ONE
TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN
THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND
TARRANT COUNTY**

OAG Contract Number: 22-00087

This Cooperative Agreement Amendment (“Amendment One”) is entered into by and between the Office of the Attorney General (the “OAG”) and Tarrant County (the “County”). In this Contract, the OAG and the County may be referred to individually as (a “Party”) or collectively as (the “Parties”). The OAG and the County entered into this Contract effective September 1, 2021; the purpose of this amendment is to revise the contract language referencing the Internal Revenue Service publication 1075 to the current revision. Replacing the existing language will eliminate the need for updates. The Parties now desire to amend the term(s) of the Contract and agree as follows:

1. Section 7.2.3 Statutory, Regulatory and Policy Compliance

Section 7.2.3 Statutory, Regulatory and Policy Compliance is replaced in its entirety with the following:

7.2.3.1 The County agrees to comply with all OAG policies, standards and requirements, state and federal statutes, rules, regulations, and standards regarding the protection and confidentiality of OAG Data, for which it has received notice, as currently effective, subsequently enacted or as may be amended. The existing requirements that are applicable to the County’s obligations under this Contract are included in this Contract.

7.2.3.2 The County shall also comply with any requirements set forth in IRS Publication 1075 (current revision) “Tax Information Security Guidelines for Federal, State and Local Agencies – Safeguards for Protecting Federal Tax Returns and Return Information”. In lieu of attaching Publication 1075, the most up to date version of Publication 1075 may be accessed and downloaded via the IRS Safeguards Program webpage.

7.2.3.3 If applicable, the County’s solution must comply with all applicable Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Safeguard Computer Security Evaluation Matrices (SCSEMs) that apply. Current IRS SCSEMs can be found at Computer Security Compliance References and Related Topics (irs.gov).

All provisions of the Contract, except as amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect. By the signing of this Amendment, the Parties hereto understand and agree that this Amendment is hereby made a part of the Contract, as though the Amendment were set forth word-for-word therein.
