It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider a monetary donation from the Immunization Collaboration of Tarrant County (ICTC) in the amount of \$10,000.00 for the Tarrant County Public Health Department's (TCPH) back-to-school immunization program.

**BACKGROUND**

The ICTC and TCPH collaborate each year to provide immunizations for Tarrant County residents at various back-to-school events. The ICTC has donated \$10,000.00 to support upcoming annual TCPH back-to-school immunization events.

On July 2018, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #128175, accepted a \$5,000.00 monetary donation from the ICTC in support of TCPH immunization events.

If accepted, the donated funds will be used for supplies and overtime salaries necessary to support extended hours for TCPH back-to-school immunization events.
