SUBJECT: BID NO. F2025051 - PURCHASE OF HAUL TRUCKS - PRECINCTS 1 AND 4 - RUSH TRUCK CENTER - FT. WORTH - PER UNIT PRICE

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court award Bid No. F2025051, Purchase of Haul Trucks, for Precincts 1 and 4, to Rush Truck Center - Ft. Worth at the per unit price.

BACKGROUND

Notice of the County’s intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Arlington Black Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Nine hundred seventy (970) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this bid process. All documents pertaining to this bid were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested bidders. A pre-bid conference held on January 8, 2025, was attended by four (4) vendors as well as representatives from Precincts 1 and 4 and Purchasing. Four (4) bids and eight (8) no-bids were received.

The bid received from Premier Truck Group was deemed non-responsive for failure to bid items with the correct transmission.

The low bid received from Rush Truck Center - Ft. Worth meets all specifications and is acceptable to Precincts 1 and 4.

The purpose of this equipment is to haul road equipment and materials.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Precincts 1 and 4 and Purchasing that Bid No. F2025051, Purchase of Haul Trucks, be awarded to Rush Truck Center - Ft. Worth at the per unit price.
