**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2023-134, Annual Contract for Case Management Software for Sheriff's Office Internal Affairs Division, for the second and final optional twelve (12) month period at the same contract terms.

**BACKGROUND**

On September 5, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #141640, awarded RFP No. 2023-134, Annual Contract for Case Management Software for Sheriff's Office Internal Affairs Division, for the Sheriff's Office, to CI Technologies, Inc.

The award was based upon evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained options to renew for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods.

On April 16, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #143000, acknowledged notification of acquisition and vendor name change of CI Technologies, Inc. to Versaterm Public Safety US, Inc.

On August 20, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #143711, approved the first renewal option.

This software enhances the Sheriff Office's ability to generate and manage citizen complaints efficiently. It enables digital submission of forms used by the Internal Affairs Division, including those related to use-of-force incidents, vehicle pursuits, and firearm discharges. The software also supports detailed reporting based on submitted data and provides oversight tools for tracking case timelines and supervisory approvals associated with investigations of officer misconduct.

The vendor notified Purchasing in writing that they will extend the same contract terms through September 4, 2026. The Sheriff's Office notified Purchasing in writing that they are pleased with the vendor and want to renew.
