

**PROCLAMATION
COMMEMORATING THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF HALTOM
CITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Haltom City, Texas marks its 75th anniversary on July 3rd, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Haltom City area started as Birdville, originally the county seat of Tarrant County. After losing the county seat, the residents and businesses showed steadfast character by maintaining a thriving and growing community, becoming Haltom Village in 1932, incorporating in 1949, and eventually merging with Oak Knoll in 1950; and

WHEREAS, Haltom City's growth has included a new City Hall, Police Facility, Fire Station, Senior Center, updated infrastructure, and a recently renovated Signature North Park; and

WHEREAS, in celebration of the momentous anniversary, Haltom City reopened the Signature North Park in June, providing residents with open green space, a 4-acre fishing pond, walking trails, a disc golf course, and more; and

WHEREAS, Haltom City boasts 3,400 businesses and continued development, including the Midway Logistics Industrial Park. Haltom City will soon be home to a 45,000-square-foot pickleball facility, Tarrant County's first H Mart, and a new live music venue; and

WHEREAS, Haltom City started as a population of 3,000 in 1950 and is now approaching 50,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, Haltom City is a pivotal community in Tarrant County, exemplifying economic growth and a spirit of resilience; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County, do hereby recognize the 75th Anniversary of the City of Haltom City; and
