**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider the destruction and sell as scrap metal for certain property purchased, donated, or awarded to the Tarrant Regional Auto Crimes Task Force through Forfeiture and Judgment.

**BACKGROUND**

The following property was awarded to the Tarrant County Auto Crime Task Force through forfeiture and judgment and accepted by the Commissioners Court for the use of Task Force operations; therefore, staff request the destruction and sell as scrap metal:

- 2004 Honda CBR motorcycle (Court Order#111900)
- 2004 Baja dirt bike and a 2007 Roketa dirt bike (Court Order #120000)
- small red/black motorcycle (Court Order #122523)

The following assets are no longer in use, nor do they continue to serve the program’s purpose; therefore, staff request the destruction and sell as scrap metal due to the general age and condition of the asset posing a potential safety risk to the public:

- 1989 Wells Cargo 6x12 cargo trailer (white)
- 1994 Kawasaki MC (silver)
- 1994 Kawasaki MC Gas Tank (green/white)
- 2000 Kawasaki MC Frame/Motor (green)
- 2004 Chevrolet Impala (maroon)
- 2004 Cadillac SRX (blue)
- 2007 Kawasaki MC (grey)
- 2010 Dodge Charger (white)
- 5x6 utility flatbed trailer (black)

The scrap metal proceeds will be deposited to the Tarrant Regional Auto Crimes Task Force program income account in the manner prescribed by the Texas Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Administrative Guidelines.
