COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider a request to use the Subcourthouse at Mansfield from Justice of the Peace, Precinct 7 for the Texas Challenge Academy meeting on March 29, 2025.

BACKGROUND

Texas Challenge Academy is a voluntary residential program designed for students between sixteen and eighteen years old across Texas who face challenges in achieving success in a traditional high school setting. The program provides opportunities for students to earn or recover academic credits, enabling them to progress toward obtaining either a high school diploma or a GED.

Justice of the Peace, Precinct 7, began utilizing the services of Texas Challenge Academy in 2013 to support truant conduct offenders. Since then, more than one hundred (100) students have been referred to the program to explore available educational opportunities. Over fifty (50) students have graduated, earning a high school diploma, a GED, or in some cases, both. Many students have recovered high school credits and returned to their local high schools on track to graduate. The program has led to numerous success stories, with graduates pursuing military careers or other professional opportunities.

Justice of the Peace, Precinct 7, completed the required property use forms and is requesting all usage fees be waived.

The Constable's Office agreed to provide security during non-business hours for this meeting.

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated fiscal impact based on salary average overtime rates for Facilities Management and the Constable's Office is approximately \$345. Salary cost will be charged to the following accounts:

TCA collaborates with Rice CISD to provide academic opportunities to recover/earn credits and advance towards earning a high school diploma or a GED. TCA is a rigorous, quasi-military structured program with a curriculum that integrates eight core components: Academic Excellence, Life Coping Skills, Health & Hygiene, Physical Fitness, Job Skills, Leadership/Followership, Service to Community, and Responsible Citizenship.

Program Structure

Texas ChalleNGE Academy is a 17 ½ month long program:

- 5 ½ months Residential
- 12 months post residential
- Quasi Military Structure
- Co-Ed Program

- 2 Classes per year (July & January)
- Academic Opportunities
- Earn/Recover Credits
- Eligible students may earn a HS diploma or GED

Requirements

- Resident of the United States & Texas
- 16-18 years old on start date
- At risk of dropping out, behind on credits, disengaged in school
- No felonies, no significant involvement with the law
- Physically/mentally capable of completing the program

Application Process

1. Attend Presentation
2. Submit a complete cadet application
3. Schedule a student interview
4. Receive Acceptance Letter within 3 weeks
5. Receive Reporting Instructions and Packing List
