COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, September 3, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. to consider authorizing the installation of multiple stop signs within the Newark Ranch Subdivision in Precinct 4. The public hearing will provide an opportunity for public input, after which the Court may take action to authorize the installations.

BACKGROUND

Citizen inquiry to Transportation Services reported that the Newark Ranch Subdivision lacks stop signs at several intersections. For public safety, the County Engineer conducted a site visit and recommended that Precinct 4 staff install stop signs at the locations listed below. Installation of these stop signs requires a Court Order passed by the Commissioners Court.

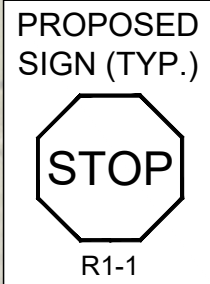
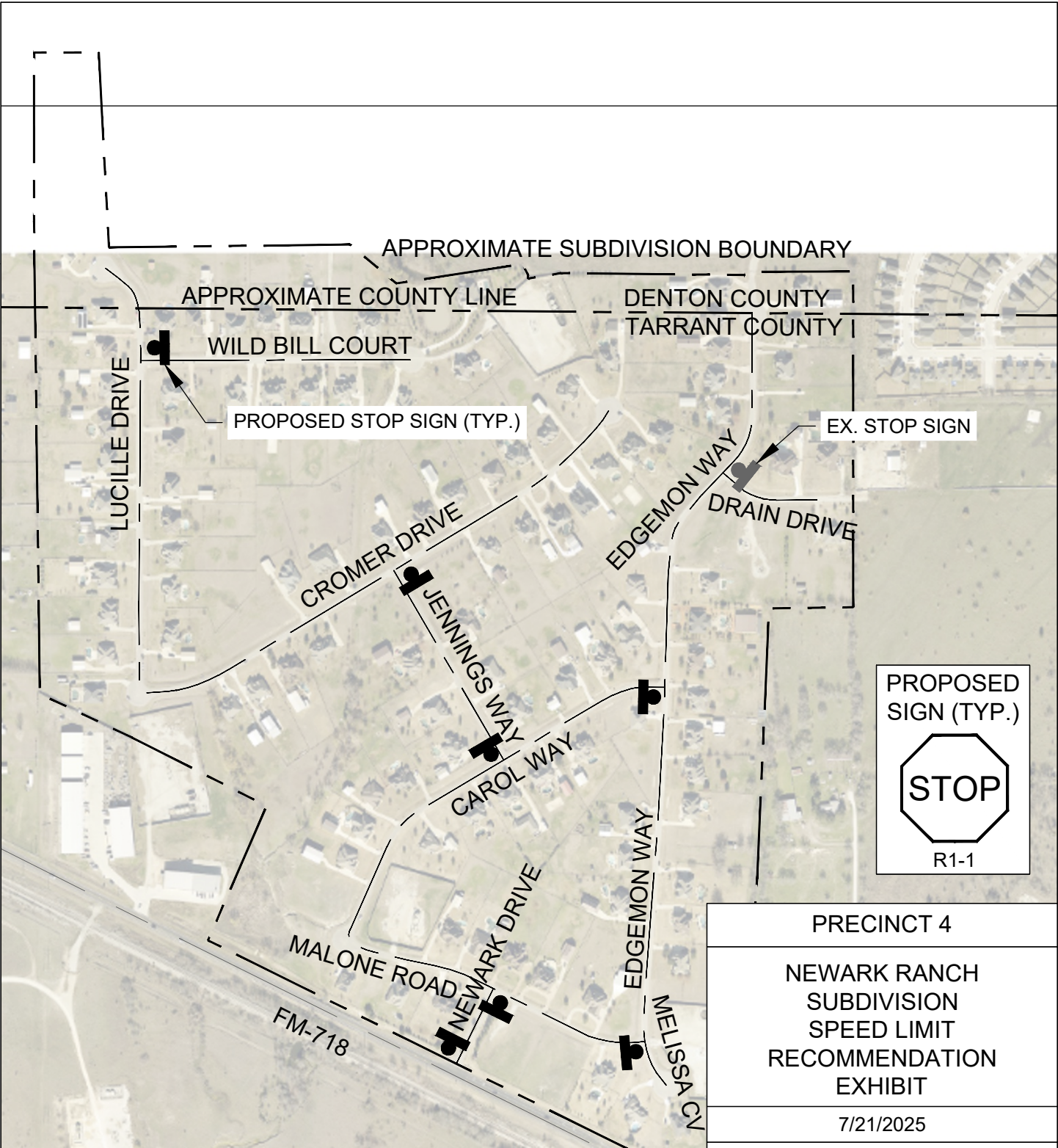

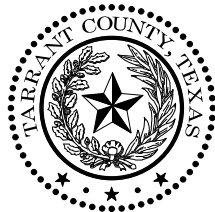

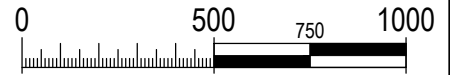
