It is requested that the Commissioners Court acknowledge notification of merger and vendor name change of IonWave Technologies LLC (formerly IonWave Technologies, Inc.) to Euna Solutions, Inc

BACKGROUND

On January 17, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #140138, awarded RFP No. 2021-068, Electronic Procurement System, for Purchasing, to IonWave Technologies LLC (formerly IonWave Technologies, Inc.)

The award was based upon evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained options to renew for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods.

On November 7, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142103, approved the first renewal option.

On January 14, 2025, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #144566 approved the second renewal option.

Tarrant County received notification of the vendor's name change from IonWave Technologies LLC to Euna Solutions, Inc., effective December 31, 2024.

Euna Solutions, Inc. agreed in writing to honor all terms and conditions as stated in the original contract.

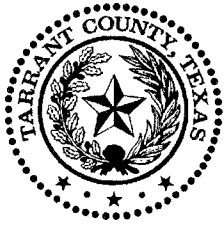
