SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING - TO CONSIDER A STOP SIGN ON HERITAGE COURT AND ON HERITAGE DRIVE - PRECINCT 1

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court conduct a public hearing to consider installing a stop sign on Heritage Court and on Heritage Drive.

BACKGROUND

Citizen inquiry raised concern to Transportation Services that Heritage Court does not have a stop sign at the the intersection with Heritage Drive. The County Engineer performed a site visit and recommended the installation of a stop sign at this location for public safety.

Additionally, the County Engineer recommends that an existing yield sign at the intersection of Heritage Drive and Burleson Retta Road be replaced with a stop sign.

A separate action for placement of the proposed stop signs will be presented to the Court for consideration.

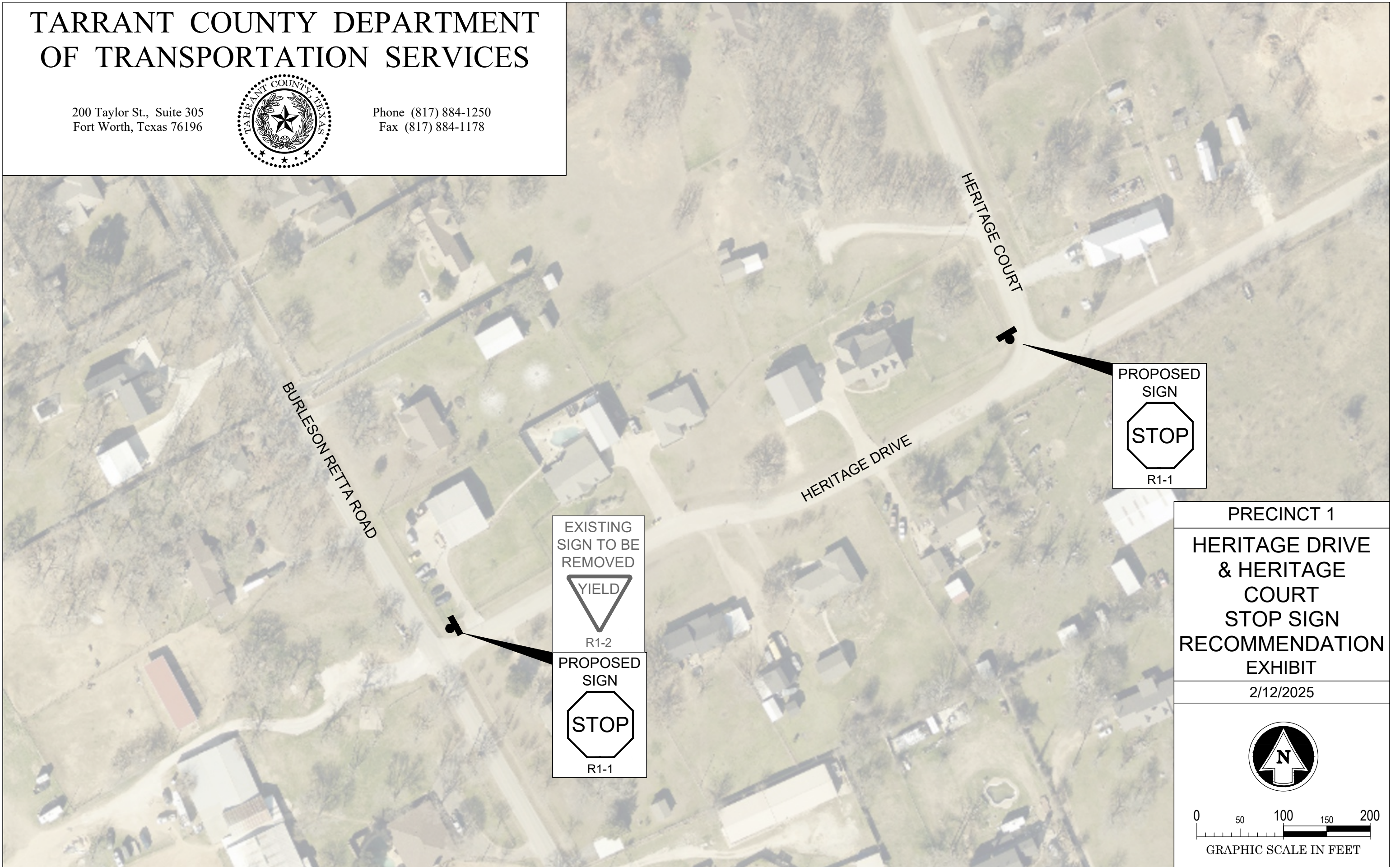
